### PLEASE NOTE:

- A) A cleaning fee of \$250 will be assessed to any vendor if their area is left with any items or trash after 3pm on 4/26/21.
- B) It is against Arizona law to sell Cannabis outside of a dispensary, which includes any value trades. Please follow the law when at an Erri Cup Event, violators will be ejected and reported to the police.
- C) Every vendor booth is required to have hand sanitizer available for attendees who visit your booth to use.
- D) There is a strict no sharing allowed. Please do not have community bongs, rigs, joints, blunts, food or beverage in your area. Help us stay safe by ensuring everyone has their own device.

## **Vendor F.A.Q.'s**

### **When can I get my vendor packet?**

Exhibitor Packets will not be mailed. Vendor Packet along with tickets/wristbands are issued to the Exhibitor's Representative during the first day of check-in, if not picked-up by appointment from the Errl Cup office at 929 E Indian School Rd.

### **What time should vendors be setup by?**

The earlier the better, setting up the day before will make it easier for you. All booths must be fully set-up by 8:30am Saturday.

### **When can vendors setup?**

Friday 04/23/2021 between 11am to 5pm. Saturday 5am to 8:30am. Outside of those hours the vendor entrance is closed.

### **What can we give away at the Errl Cup?**

Swag, FREE cannabis samples, collectables, coupons, hand-outs, clothing, stickers and the like are authorized give away at Errl Cup. However due to the increased limitations surrounding COVID-19 it is recommended you provide any giveaways prepackaged. There is a strict NO Sharing and BYOBong rules to protect visitors and staff from COVID-19.

### **Where will vendors park? Where will attendee park?**

Vendor will have 1 parking inside of the venue to the south west by vendor check-in.

Sponsors have 2 parking inside of the venue to the south west by vendor check-in.

Attendees and all other vendors / sponsor employees can park on-site with a cost associated from the scarizona venue.

### **Can vendors get extra Vendor pass?**

Yes. Each extra vendor pass will be an additional \$20.00 charge.

### **Can vendors get VIP tickets?**

Yes. Each VIP ticket is sold to vendors at \$55.00 per ticket and is good for 2 days.

## **What are the COVID-19 guidelines for camp?**

### **Physical Distancing**

You are required to follow all six-foot physical distancing markers that will be displayed throughout common areas inside and outside the Errl Cup Venue. These markers will designate how to enter security gates, restrooms, shops and concessions. Remember, we're in this together so make sure to be respectful of other attendees and their space.

### **Face Coverings**

Facial coverings are mandatory for everyone at Errl Cup Venue and must be worn at all times, unless you are actively eating or drinking. Vented face masks and face shields without a face covering underneath will NOT be permitted. Each ticketholder will receive a free mask from our sponsor as they enter the venue. Attendees are strongly encouraged to wear these masks to protect themselves and other Attendees.

### **Hygiene**

Hand sanitizer is required to be at your booth for visitors to use before and after interacting with you.

### **First Aid**

If you begin to feel ill on event day, you should get help immediately. An attendee dedicated isolation area will be available for any attendee that begins to feel ill after entering the venue. The venue's onsite medical team will be fully prepared to treat you on-site and provide you with personal protective equipment, if necessary. If you feel ill at any point before leaving or on your way to the venue, we ask that you please be a good teammate and stay home.

### **Proximity to Players and Each Other**

Several areas will be closed off to create distance between Attendees and exhibitors. Additionally, Errl Cup Venue will be blocking off seats to support physical distancing.

### **Cash Free Payments**

In order to limit touchpoints and create an efficient event day experience for our Attendees, all exhibitors should offer digital payment acceptance for Attendees throughout the venue, including parking, concessions, and retail.

### **Enhanced Cleaning**

You are responsible for hourly cleaning of any high touch/traffic areas at your booth/exhibit.

### **Staff Temperature Checks**

All staff, vendors, volunteers and attendees will have their temperature taken before entering the venue. Any temperature above 100.4°F will be flagged, and that person will be sent home.

**Face Coverings and PPE**

Like Attendees, all staff will be required to wear a face covering at all times. They will also be required to complete a health screening questionnaire before entering the venue on event day. For those staff who work in concessions or handle any "high touch" surfaces, gloves will also be required.

All vendors agree that they will not come to an Erri Cup event unless they can confirm, on behalf of themselves and their guests, that none of the following are true as of the day of the event.

- Within the last 14 days, vendors have not tested positive for, or been exposed to, COVID-19
- Within the last 48 hours, vendors have not experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., fever of 100.4° F or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, or any other symptoms associated with COVID-19 identified by the CDC)
- Within the last 14 days, vendors have not travelled to any state or international territory identified by federal or applicable local governments as being subject to travel or quarantine advisories due to COVID-19

Please note: the CDC has detailed advice for older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions please see the CDC website for recommendations and advice.

Vendors also must agree that to help maintain physical distancing guidelines.
